



OmniGlobe Networks Completes Acquisition of RAMTelecom

OmniGlobe strengthens its North American business, extending its connectivity capabilities to the oil and gas, mining, forestry and government markets

(www.omniglobe.com), the global telecommunications company specializing in the delivery of broadband internet, cellular and satellite communications products and services, today announces the conclusion of its acquisition of Ottawa-based R. A. Misener Telecom Corporation (known as RAMTelecom). The acquisition, which was announced in December 2008, has been approved by the board of directors of each company.

RAMTelecom is a leading Canadian satellite service provider that offers services for broadband data and voice business communications to medium and large enterprises in the oil and gas, mining and forestry sectors as well as government agencies. Its fixed and mobile satellite-based services provide complete coverage of North America, giving organizations the ability to deliver continuous real-time communications between central and remote offices, regardless of location.

This strategic acquisition marks a new milestone for OmniGlobe Networks, which was recently identified as "Canada's #1 Growth Technology Company" by the BRANHAM group. It also signals the company's determination to strengthen its position in the remote and rural communications sector and to further extend its reach into new and growing commercial markets.

Jason Neale, OmniGlobe's founder and CEO, says: "The RAMTelecom acquisition fits perfectly with our business expansion strategy of delivering broadband and cellular services to remote and rural communities and enterprises around the world. With 10 years of experience in the industry, RAMTelecom has the creativity and agility to address communication challenges and an excellent track record of providing high quality business communication services to its existing client base."

He adds: "The market for communications services in remote and rural areas is a solidly growing sector of the global telecommunications industry and, moving forward, our focus will be to build on RAM's North American commercial and operational expertise and to extend it to the oil and gas, mining and forestry markets internationally."

Julian Costley, OmniGlobe's chairman, says: "Acquiring RAMTelecom is an important step forward for OmniGlobe in growing its business organically and through acquisition. RAMTelecom brings new market



sector strength, more geographic coverage and reinforces our senior management team. The synergies between the two companies are excellent and we complement each other in personnel and resources. RAMTelecom has a dedicated and knowledgeable team of experts with an in-depth understanding of the communication challenges facing companies operating on a national and international scale."

Ralph Misener, CEO and founder of RAMTelecom, comments: "The primary advantage for RAMTelecom's present and future customers is the increased support behind superior satellite services - including customer support, meticulous network monitoring and the provision of flexible, value-added options to meet individual consumer needs. With the addition of OmniGlobe's engineering expertise and full range of services, the extended line-up of telecom products will further enhance our clients' remote operations with wider choices for satellite bandwidth, local wireless connectivity and cellular capabilities that were not previously available to them."

RAMTelecom will be fully integrated into OmniGlobe. Its satellite activities will be combined with OmniGlobe's satellite-WiMAX and broadband business to become the new broadband communications division. This division will be based in and operated from Ottawa, with teleport facilities in Ottawa, Montreal and a future site in Western Canada.

The mobile satellite phone activities will be combined with OmniGlobe's satellite-cellular activities to become the new cellular communications division based in and operated from Montreal, with teleport, CDMA and inter-carrier facilities in Montreal, with again a future site in Western Canada. As part of the acquisition, Mr Gilles R Desmarais, Chief Operating Officer of RAMTelecom, will be appointed as OmniGlobe's North American VP of sales and marketing, spanning both divisions. Mr Ralph Misener will become a permanent adviser to OmniGlobe
